Australian Formula 1 Grand Prix Works Albert Park 2019

On 31st January 2019, the Primary school at the northern end of the Albert Park precinct opens to students.

Over the next 5 years, the school will take in more students until the school reaches its capacity of approximately 600 students.

APP representatives have been part of the consultation programme for parking for student drop off and pick up.

Approximately 10 car parks on the western side of the Lakeside stadium car park have been set aside for use by parents dropping off and picking up students.

The pedestrian crossing that is approximately 100 metres north of the roundabout entry to the Lakeside Car Park will be used by students entering the school at a school gate located on the footpath which runs along side Aughtie Drive. The pedestrian crossing is not very visible to road users, please be alert to the location of the pedestrian crossing.

There is also a car park available to parents in the slip lane between Aughtie Drive and the MSAC entry off Albert Road. This area has been designated as a *Kiss 'n Go zone*.

We ask that all cyclists exercise extreme caution when travelling north out of the park on Aughtie Drive during school hours which are:

- 8:00am – 9:30 am
- 2:30 pm-4:00 pm.

There are no immediate plans for the local council to put in place a school crossing programme.

Please be thoughtful and considerate of the school community during school start and finish times.
