Before you start!

Check your eligibility

To be eligible for a Foreshore Club parking permit you must provide club or association identification.



Get your permit

Submit your application at any **Port Phillip town hall** with payment. Email submissions will not be accepted.



Receive your permit

When applying in person, your permit will be issued on the spot.
